

# Activities

QUING integrates five activities

## LARG

a comparative analysis of differences, similarities and inconsistencies in the field of gender+ equality between the EU and its member states. It provided a systematic overview of these policies in terms of their design and content, devoting particular attention to the voice and standing given to civil society. Moreover, it developed a methodology that combines Frame Analysis with an innovative Voice Analysis.

## WHY

explains similarities, differences and inconsistencies that are present in gender+ equality policies across the EU and its member states (as analysed by LARG), giving special attention to differences in civil-society interfaces.

## STRIQ

a study on how intersectionality is currently dealt with in gender+ equality policies across the European Union and its member states, including the study of occurrences of intersectional bias.

## FRAGEN

the construction of a database of gender+ equality frames that originate in feminist movements in Europe, leading to an open database.

## OPERA

the integration of knowledge on gender, intersectionality and European gender equality policies into operational standards for gender+ training, including the training of trainers.
